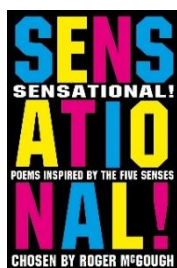


## Oak Class Newsletter - Summer 2025

### Curriculum



This term we will be reading *The London Eye Mystery* and *Sensational!* in our English lessons, to practise our key comprehension skills. We will also use them as a basis for our writing topics too. In maths, we will be studying geometry, ratio, proportion and volume, alongside consolidating our arithmetic skills.



In science lessons, we will continue learning about our four current subjects using our spiral curriculum. These will include lessons on light, electricity, evolution and the circulatory system. Our RE topic is called *To the Ends of the Earth*. We will reflect on the Resurrection and martyrdom. We will learn about different saints and Christian charitable organisations, that help people facing injustice. History lessons will focus on the Vikings and the Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England, to the time of Edward Confessor. Our art topic this term is drawing.

### Homework

Children are expected to read and talk about their book to an adult every night for at least 20 minutes. Reading to an adult is important for every year group. Please list all books that you read in your yellow reading log.
