### SPELLING:

Every morning, we will begin the day with spelling work. This will build on the children's knowledge of phonics and begin to explore spelling rules.

### ENGLISH:

Our first focus in English will be a contemporary picture book 'The Dragon Machine'. The children will focus of Following that they will be reading 'The Egg Box Dragon'

### MATHS:

Building on the work we started in the Autumn Term, we will continue to look at the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division). We will explore division in more detail and continue to look at the relationship between multiplication, division and fractions. We will look at telling the time - o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to. We will also look at measurements of length, weight, capacity and temperature.

### SCIENCE:

In science we will be looking at the properties and uses of materials, observing and describing seasonal changes, identifying and naming animals including fish, mammals, amphibians reptiles and birds and identifying and naming a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees.

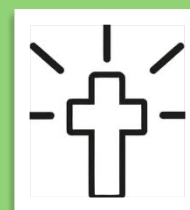
