



Class 4 Newsletter - Summer 2024

Curriculum



This term we will be reading *The Adventures of Odysseus* and *Phoenix* in our English lessons, to practise our key comprehension skills. We will also use them as a basis for our writing topics. In maths, we will be studying geometry, ratio and proportion, as well as consolidating our arithmetic skills.



In science lessons, we will continue learning about our four subjects using our spiral curriculum. These will include lessons on Earth & Space, Forces, Living things and Materials. Our RE topics are Life in the Risen Lord, Pentecost and learning about another faith. In Geography we will continue to focus on North America, before starting our new history topic on World War II. Our studies will be based around the Battle of Britain.

Homework
