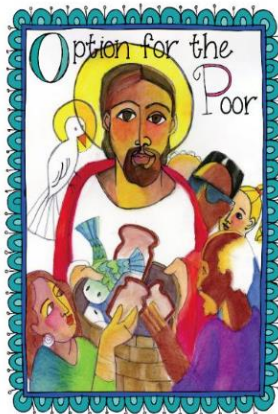
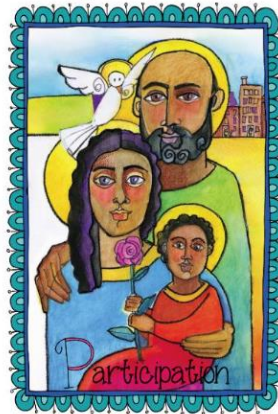


Everyone should have access to their fair share of resources.

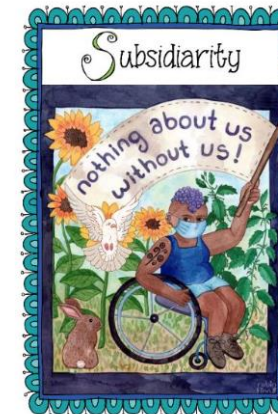
We all have a right and a duty to participate in society.



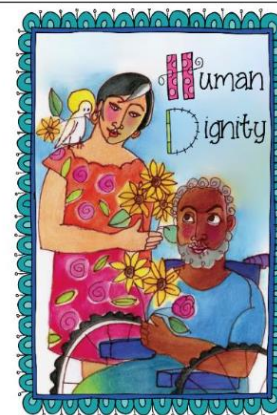
We can be God's instruments of peace through seeking justice.
